Dear Parent/Guardian

Please find attached the homework timetable for 2011/12. Homework will be set according to the timetable and when pieces of extended homework are given pupils should work on them each week on the day allocated to the subject to avoid an excessive workload on some nights. The timetable provides you with an outline of the types of homework that will be set.

Pupils will use their pupil planner to record homework given, it would be helpful if parents would check and sign the planner on a weekly basis. We recommend the following as a guide for parents

Year 7 and 8                    50-75 minutes per day  
Year 9                            1 hour 30 minutes per day  
Year 10 and 11                1 hour 45 minutes per day

If pupils are absent they have a responsibility to see teachers/other students to assist in catching up. We would strongly advise against booking holidays in term time in Years 10 and 11. Extended absence results in loss of class contact/individual teacher instruction/coursework support/group work and puts a heavy burden on pupils to keep up to date.

If there are any problems concerning homework contact your child's form tutor in the first instance.
